I grant Southern Natural Gas Company's (Southern) April 14, 2008 request to commence service on Phase II of the Cypress Pipeline Project, which consists of an electric-driven compressor unit at the Brookman Compressor Station in Glynn County, Georgia. Your request was filed in compliance with environmental condition 8 of the Commission's June 15, 2006 Order, as amended by the Commission's July 24, 2007 Order (Orders), issued to Southern in the above-referenced docket. This authorization is based on our April 15, 2008 field inspection of the project and Southern's recent bi-weekly status report, which confirm that Southern has adequately stabilized the compressor station work area with sufficient erosion control devices and that restoration is proceeding satisfactorily.
